#### **Project Description**

The Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency is providing financing to construct a seawater desalination plant intended to provide 50,000 cubic meters/ day of water to the Cagzhou Bohai Development Zone. The plant will be constructed by Aqualyng New Water Resources Company, and will have a total area of approximately 45,000 square meters and include: a main process building (including control room, dosing, filtration, pump, and distribution warehouse, etc.); clean water tank; clarification tank; and auxiliary facilities.

The project was expected to begin construction in September 2015 and is expected to finish by September 2017.

The project will obtain water from the Bahai Bay.
