Project Description

According to bank documents, on December 22, 2017, MIGA signed a contract in which it agreed to issue \$14.49 million in guarantees to Acciona Energia Global S.L.U. of Spain and Enara Bahrain SPV WLL of Bahrain for its investment into Al Subh Solar Power S.A.E. The guarantees are issued for up to 15 years against the risks of Transfer Restriction and Inconvertibility, Expropriation, War and Civil Disturbance, and Breach of Contract.

The project is part of Egypt's Feed-in-Tariff Round Two program. It consists of the design, development, construction, operation and maintenance of a greenfield solar IPP facility with installed capacity of 50 MW located in the Benban solar PV park in the Aswan Governorate of Egypt.
