

According to the bank website, the proposed investment "involves a loan to an existing operator of a high voltage transmission line in Cambodia. The lenders have applied for MIGA guarantees covering up to US\$76 million of their debt investment into the project. The guarantees will have a term of up to 10 years, providing coverage against the risks of transfer restriction, expropriation, war and civil disturbance and breach of contract. The project will improve the financial viability of the transmission line operator by enabling a loan from international banks on competitive terms."
