According to the bank website, "This Early Disclosure covers an application by JPMorgan Chase Bank N.A., London Branch ("JPM") on behalf of itself and other commercial bank lenders yet to be identified, for their non-shareholder loans to the Government of Serbia ("GoS") represented by the Ministry of Finance ("MoF"), for the construction of a 112 kilometer ("km") highway and flood prevention systems along the West Morava River ("the Project"). JPM is seeking a Non Honoring of Sovereign Financial Obligation (NHSFO) guarantee of up to USD 550 million, for a period of up to 15 years."
