Project Description

The proposed Projects entail the construction, ownership, operation and maintenance of two solar energy generating facilities, with a capacity of 5MW each, in the Omaheke region in Namibia. The electricity output will be sold to the Namibia Power Corporation (Pty) Ltd under a 25-year Power Purchase Agreement. Both Projects were awarded through the Renewable Feed in Tariff Program. The expected development impact from the Projects include: (i) diversification of Namibia's energy mix; (ii) contribution to increased generation capacity in Namibia; (iii) reduction of carbon emissions by producing green, emission-free electricity; (iv) promotion of employment and skills development during construction and operation and; (v) providing positive demonstration effects for solar development in Namibia and neighboring countries. The proposed project is aligned with MIGA's priorities of facilitating investments that address climate change.
