The project would thus contribute to Myanmar's move towards UHC. It would also support a prompt and effective response to crises and emergencies. The project consists of three components. The first component strengthening Service Delivery at the Primary Health Care Level, focuses on channeling funds through MOH to the states/regions and townships (the latter in the form of health facility grants) for operational expenses or non-salary recurrent expenditures.
