## Project Description

The project's objective is to improve management of fisheries at regional and national levels including support to establish mariculture in targeted atolls in the Maldives. The project components are directly linked to the wellbeing of the regional fishery stock. The project will consist of two components; one will focus on improving the currently inadequately managed capture fishery, and the other one will support diversifying the fisheries economy so that sufficient jobs and income are created outside capture fishery to reduce stress on the regionally shared fish stock. Both components will build improved resilience in Maldives.
