The Program Development Objective of the Development Policy Financing is to support government's efforts in: (i) increasing revenue mobilization, stabilizing the wage bill, and improving efficiency and transparency in procurement practices to strengthen fiscal balance; (ii) improving the business climate and developing ICT services to enhance competitiveness; and (iii) improving the efficiency of health care delivery and social protection services to protect the poor.

The operation is organized around three pillars:

(1) strengthening fiscal balance; (2) enhancing competitiveness; and (3) protecting the poor each including several policy areas
