Project Description

According to project documents, the purported objective of this grant is to support the Ministry of Education (MENFP) in 1) developing a sustainable data collection strategy for the school census that delivers quality data comparable to international standards, 2) designing a ministry-wide strategy for strengthening their M&E system, 3) implementing this strategy; and 4) to strengthen the capacity of the Haiti National Statistics Institute for data collection critical to education.

The total project cost is US\$0.5 million, to be financed by the World Bank through a grant from the Trust Fund for Statistical Capacity Building.
