According to the bank document, The program development objective is to: (i) strengthen public financial management; and (ii) improve the environment for inclusive growth. These two components correspond to the two pillars of the operation. The first pillar is supported through strengthening the management of public assets and liabilities, and improving public procurement. The second pillar is supported through improving oversight of joint ventures in the fisheries industry, improving the quality and expanding the coverage of essential public utilities, and facilitating competition and universal service provision in the telecommunications industry.
