Project Description

According to the bank, the project aims to support the reform agenda of the Government of Tuvalu in the areas of: (i) improving health and education service delivery; and (ii) building macroeconomic sustainability. These two areas are central to the National Strategy for Sustainable Development (NSSD) or Te Kakeega III (TKIII), and to the Regional Partnership Framework (RPF) for nine small Pacific Island Countries FY2017-FY2022 including Tuvalu. The project is part of a coordinated budget support mechanism through which Australia, New Zealand, the Asian Development Bank (ADB), and the European Union (EU) also provide budget support.
