Project Description

According to WB website, the project aims to increase access to land, private sector finance, input and output markets by smallholder farms from private-public partnerships (PPPs) in commercial agriculture in the Accra Plains and Savannah Accelerated Development Authority (SADA) zone. The additional credit will be accompanied by a restructuring of the project, and an extension of the closing date by fifteen (15) months from September 30, 2019 to December 31, 2020. The PDO has been reviewed by removing the reference to increased access to reliable water, land, finance and agricultural input and output markets which mainly define the interventions undertaken by the project to achieve the development objectives.
