## Project Description

The development objective of the Local Government Support Project for Burkina Faso is to strengthen the central government's capacity for administrative and fiscal decentralization and the institutional capacities of communes in six regions, and to improve accountability linkages between local policy makers and citizens in the six regions. The project has four components: establishment of the foundations for robust administrative and fiscal intergovernmental institutions to support the central government to establish a transparent and rule-based intergovernmental fiscal framework and robust intergovernmental administrative systems; strengthening capacity of municipalities to manage local development by providing resources to communes through institutional development grants; improving citizen participation in local governance to strengthen local government accountability for service delivery.
