## **Project Description**

According to the World Bank, the objectives of this development project are to enhance the resilience of agriculture and ecosystems in selected watersheds and to enable the Government of Haiti to repond promptly and effectively to emergencies.

To accomplish these objectives, the project will include the following four components:

- Strengthening of institutional and organisational capacity for landscape level interventions. This part of the project will receive US\$10 million. This component will specifically target institutional capacity building, supporting a national level landscape approach to agriculture and watersheds, supporting farmer organisations, and establish a biodiversity fund.
- 2. Investments to promote agriculture and ecosystems resilience in the areas of interventions. This part of the project will receive US\$14 million. This component will provide support to farmers and farmers' organisations within the targeted zones to increase productivity, diversify agricultural production, and boost landscape resilience to the impacts of climate change. To this end, the component may include investments in climate resilient agriculture, intensification, diversification, and commercialisation of agriculture, and building landscape resilience.
- 3. Project management, monitoring, and evaluation. This part of the project will receive US\$3 million. It will finance the purchase of goods, equipment, incremental operating costs, studies, and other expenses for management of project implementation.
- 4. Emergency response mechanism. This part of the project will receive no allocated funds. Instead it will be used as a conduit for the use of uncommitted funds to implement activities in the event of an eligible emergency.

## **People Affected By This Project**

According to the World Bank, the total number of farmers in the targeted area are estimated to be 300,000. The cited primary beneficiaries are estimated by the World Bank in the range of 15,000-20,000 organised farmers in selected watersheds. The World Bank says it will conduct a more detailed analysis in later steps of the project.
