## Project Description

According to the bank, the project will "improve the food and nutritional situation and the productive, income generating capacities of targeted poor and vulnerable smallholder farming communities in the project areas. The design of the components of the project is based on the lessons learnt from the implementation of ongoing projects including the recently closed Agriculture and Food Security Project (AFSP) funded by the Global Agriculture and Food Security Program (GAFSP).

The Project will have four interrelated components: 1. Climate and Nutrition Smart Technology adaptation and dissemination; 2. Income generation and diversification; 3. Improving nutrition security ; and 4. Project management, communication and M&E.
