The investments supported by the project therefore include the development and enhancement of climate-resilientinfrastructure and production systems; adoption of sustainable landscape management practices, information systems and decision support tools; and institutional strengthening at the national and subnational levels. Investments will also support the strengthening of the enabling environment for private sector to invest in natural resources.
