This project provides support for activities promoting youth-focused community mobilization and social accountability activities. According to Bank documents, the project aims to ensure that:

- 1. Communities, particularly youth and marginalized groups, are actively engaged in selecting poverty-focused project interventions
- 2. Investments in social and economic infrastructure (including electricity) are those that have been most highly prioritized by communities
- 3. All members of the target communities are provided with the information, facilitation and capacity building necessary to make decisions that are needs-based, and inclusive of women, vulnerable, and poor households

Components include support for community mobilization and capacity building, and for youth engagement in awareness building, participatory monitoring, and social accountability.
