## Project Description

This project will fund activities for the implementation of the International Comparison Program (ICP). The ICP is a worldwide statistical initiative to collect comparative price data and estimate purchasing power parities of the world's countries. The ICP governance framework consists of the United Nations Statistical Commission (UNSC), a Governing Board, an Inter-Agency Coordination Group, Technical Advisory Group and Task Forces, a Global Implementing Agency, Regional Implementing Agencies, and National Implementing Agencies, each of which has distinct roles and responsibilities.

This project will fund the following components:

1. Arrangement of regional workshops
2. Participation in international meetings and conferences
3. Preparation of operational materials and calculation of PPP estimates
4. Production of knowledge materials and publications
