- (2) An Enterprise Innovation Programme which will provide grants to companies that produce proof of commercially realising the research completed as part of the applied Research and Development programme.
- (3) Policy and Capacity Building Support which will establish a central Technology Transfer Office to provide a wide range of complementary technology commercialisation services.
