### Project Description

According to the Bank's website, this project aims to strengthen: (a) the resilience of students and school staff to the emotional and physical impacts of natural disasters; and (b) the child protection systems and services to improve preparation and response to natural disasters.

This will entail the following components: (i) creating and promoting learning environments and safe spaces for children and adolescents; (ii) strengthening the sector and individual school's capacity to prepare and respond to natural disasters; (iii) strengthening the child protection system including policies, institutional mechanisms and practices; and (iv) supporting the administration, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the project.
