The ERIK Project had been approved by the World Bank Board of Executive Directors on May 25, 2018, in the amount of US\$20 million (US\$10 million equivalent IDA Credit 6238-KG and US\$10 million equivalent IDA Grant D318-KG) and became effective on February 26, 2019.

Component 1: Strengthening Disaster Preparedness and Response Systems (original estimated cost: US\$4 million)

Component 2: Improving Safety and Functionality of School Infrastructure (original estimated cost: US\$12 million)
