Early Warning System Project Analysis

Environmental and social risks are rater as Substantial.

The potential environmental and social risks and impacts will be mostly relevant to Components 1 and 2 and be comprised of impacts on aquatic and terrestrial habitats due to construction of flood management structures, river bed alteration, water pollution, land clearance and impacts on floodplain habitats and vegetation, use of borrow and aggregate material as well as typical construction risks and impacts such as air and noise emissions, waste management, soil management, labor and working conditions, occupational health and safety risks, community health and safety (including traffic safety), risk of increased SEA/SH incidents due to labor influx; increased transmission risks of COVID-19 from incoming workers; structural safety of the flood protection structures depending on the size, habitat disturbance due to construction and economic displacement due to the required land acquisition for construction activities. Physical displacement is not expected.
