Project Description

According to the WB, the objectives of the Support to the Bogota Metro Line 1 Project Series Two are to (i) increase access to socio-economic opportunities in L1's area of influence, and (ii) improve public transport services. There are two components to the project: the first component is civil works, rolling stock, rail control systems, signaling, and equipment. This component funds civil works for L1, including a 23.9 km elevated viaduct, 16 elevated rail stations, and 10 BRT stations with infrastructure for universal accessibility. It covers foundations, superstructures, BRT lanes on Caracas Ave, and station access for pedestrians and cyclists. This component also supports the acquisition, assembly, and delivery of 23 fully electric trains (each with a capacity of 1,800 passengers) equipped with advanced safety, ventilation, noise reduction, and anti-trapping features. The second component is the project management and capacity strengthening. This component will finance technical assistance for project management, independent financial audits, works supervision (interventoria), and the operationalization of the concession contract clause to recruit women in medium-skilled jobs, particularly for L1 operations and maintenance, through an action plan addressing barriers to recruitment, retention, and promotion.
