Project Description

According to bank's website, the proposed project is the first phase of the Saint Paul 2 Hydropower Project (SP2) Multiphase Programmatic Approach in Liberia. Phase 1 is designed to establish the enabling conditions for private sector investment in the SP2 hydropower development while improving access to infrastructure and selected services for communities in the project area. The operation comprises four components: (i) Main Works Investment Readiness, including PPP transaction support, technical review, and preparation of environmental and social instruments for the main hydropower scheme; (ii) Early Works and Associated Infrastructure, including access roads, river crossings, site offices, and worker camps; (iii) Environmental and Social Management, including land acquisition and resettlement, community development and benefit-sharing activities, biodiversity and other environmental and social management measures, stakeholder engagement, and grievance redress; and (iv) Institutional Strengthening and Project Management, including implementation support, supervision, and capacity building for sector institutions and LEC.
