The activities included under the proposed phase 1 project are targeting priorities for improving access, quality and reliability of water supply services, reducing water demand and NRW, optimizing operating costs with the objective to improve the AUWSSC and Kandahar Strategic Business Unit (KSBU)'s performance. The proposed project will include four components: Component 1: Water Supply Infrastructure and Efficiency Improvements; Component 2: Sector Reform, Institutional Strengthening, and Capacity Building; Component 3: Project Management and Monitoring; and Component 4: Contingent Emergency Response Component."
