Project Description

The technical assistance will implement national climate change policy and develop greenhouse gas reduction technologies. It will explore carbon capture and storage as a potential strategy by developing a demonstration schedule, engaging in dialogues with public and private sector entities, and drafting policy statements. In addition, the project will investigate CO2 emitters including energy, agriculture, transportation, and industrial sectors to determine the best type of demonstration schedule.
