## Project Description

According to bank documents, the project consists of the development, construction, operation, and maintenance of a 21 megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic (PV) power plant located in a solar park created within the Ma'an Development Area (MDA), approximately 200km southwest of the capital, Amman. The electricity generated will be sold at a fixed tariff to the National Electric Power Company (NEPCO, or the off-taker), a wholly-owned state-owned enterprise of the Government of Jordan (GoJ), under a 20-year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA). NEPCO has already built both the interconnection facilities and a dedicated substation for power evacuation from MDA into the national grid. The Project achieved commercial operations date in October 2016 and is currently undergoing testing until full completion, expected early 2017.
