### **Project Description**

The main objective of this Technical Cooperation project is to support the design and implementation of the Indigenous Entrepreneurship Support Program (CH-L1105, see Related Projects). Specific objectives are: (i) to improve the technical and social viability of indigenous entrepreneurship projects to be financed by the CH-L1105 Program; and (ii) to enhance institutional capacities of traditional indigenous authorities involved in the projects to be financed by the CH- L1105 Program.



### Investment Description

- Inter-American Development Bank (IADB)

The estimated budget for this non-reimbursable Technical Cooperation operation amounts to US\$500,000, 100% financed through the IADB's contribution. The IADB's financial contribution will go towards hiring consultants, and can finance different services to consultancies, as well as coordination costs and contingencies.
