Project Description

As stated by the ADB, the project will partly finance carbon offset projects being set up by SDG 13 Ventures Private Limited (SDGVPL), under which 1 million improved cookstoves (ICS's) will be distributed at a subsidy of about 85% of the market price to rural households that currently use inefficient traditional cookstoves. The ICS's have improved combustion, resulting in less wood consumption for cooking, reduced carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions, and decreased indoor air pollution, which in turn leads to less deforestation.
