The project aims to help improve the living conditions of the population in nine small towns. The project's specific purpose is to expand the supply of private sector water and sanitation products and services, and access to credit for local SMEs and about 60,000 ( with an average of 5 persons per household ) low income people to meet their financing needs and to allow access to new products and services and improved drinking water and basic sanitation.
