According to WB documentation, under this project, it will be provided support to Government of Mongolia for development of a comprehensive framework for sustainable urban mobility in Ulaanbaatar, and to reduce congestion, improve road safety, and address climate resilience on selected transport corridors. The project has less than twelve months implementation: it was approved on June 23, 2021. The parent Ulaanbaatar Sustainable Urban Transport Project (USUTP) ID is P174007.
