According to the IADB, the objective of the project is to contribute to the competitiveness, accessibility and connectivity of the country through the environmentally sustainable improvement of strategic infrastructure within the High Capacity Road Network of the country, as well as complementary urban interventions.

The specific objectives are:

- (i) reduce vehicle operating costs on the intervened roads;
- (ii) implement a sustainable public-private financial mechanism for operation and maintenance improvements;
- (iii) promote road safety; and
- (iv) increase the infrastructure resilience to climate change.
