To this end, studies identified as priorities for the preparation, structuring and construction of the "Tufino - Chiles" and "El Carmelo - La Victoria" border bridges will be carried out in Ecuador in the provinces of Sucumbios and Carchi, and in Colombia in the departments of Narino and Putumayo."
