## Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the project consists of an up to EUR 35 million senior secured loan to Stomana Industry AD. The proceeds of the loan will be used to finance the Company's medium term decarbonisation strategy including energy and water efficiency, quality and cost optimization measures as well as elimination of production bottlenecks. As part of the Project, Stomana will also install at its production site a PV electricity generation capacity for own use of up to 10MW to further decarbonise its operations.
