### **Project Description**

As stated by the ADB, the Issyk-Kul Environmental Management and Sustainable Tourism Development Project will: (i) improve public and environmental health conditions of the Issyk-Kul Lake area by supporting sanitation and environmental services in Cholpon-Ata; (ii) enhance livability and tourism by developing green, climate-resilient, safe, and inclusive spaces, including universal access for people with disabilities and the elderly; and (iii) boost economic recovery post coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic through promotion of inclusive and sustainable tourism development. The project will also contribute to increasing women's access to work, with positive spillover to the overall Issyk-Kul Lake area and the Almaty-Bishkek Economic Corridor (ABEC) region.
