## Project Description

This summary covers an investment by Mr. Dirieh Ali Mawel and Mrs. Samya Houssein Addillahi, two Djiboutian nationals (the Investors), into the project enterprise incorporated in Ethiopia, Alvima Import & Export PLC (the Project Enterprise), a company incorporated in Ethiopia engaged until now in food trading.

The project entails the establishment of a flour processing and pasta manufacturing plant that will produce flour as well as high-quality pasta products primarily in Adama town, 90 km South East of Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. The plant will have a daily manufacturing capacity of up to 66 tons of pasta and up to 95 tons of flour.

The Investors have applied for MIGA guarantees covering up to \$6 million of equity investments into the Project Enterprise. The guarantees will have a term of up to 10 years and will provide coverage against the risks of expropriation and war and civil disturbance.
