### Project Description

This project provides financing to Turkey for policy reforms aiming to increase domestic savings and transparency, support the economic inclusion of women, youth, long-term employed and Syrians under temporary protection, and address structural bottlenecks to sustainable growth. These changes include amendments to the Private Pension Savings and Investments Law, support for flexible employment, enacting new legal frameworks for the protection of industrial property, liberalizing the railways sector, and supporting renewable energy zones.
