### Project Description

According to EBRD website, the proceeds of the sovereign loan will be on-lent to the City of Jalal-Abad for the benefit of the municipal water and wastewater company Vodokanal and be used to finance further critical water and wastewater investments in the City including the rehabilitation of water and wastewater networks, metering, the construction of a new waste water treatment plant (WWTP) and the procurement of laboratory equipment. Further, it aims to:

1. Rehabilitate the water supply and wastewater infrastructure in the city and;
2. Improve the company's financial and operational management
