## Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the project consists of the provision of a senior unsecured long-term loan to Barry Callebaut South East Europe d.o.o. in the amount of up to EUR 82.3 million, consisting of EUR 52.3 million committed tranche and EUR 30 million uncommitted tranche.

The loan will support the Company's investment in the development of the chocolate production plant and Chocolate Academy in Serbia, as well as future investments in Serbia.

Additionally, the PCM has the authority to recommend a project be suspended in the event that harm is imminent.
