Specifically, this TC plans to develop policy management tools to: (i) improve coordination between local governments, the Ministry of the Interior and the National Police; (ii) increase police capacity to carry out intelligence and crime investigation strategies; and (iii) improve systems for collecting, managing, and analyzing criminal statistics
