### Project Description

This project finances the implementation of a holistic approach to improve the health sector that links national planning, monitoring and execution systems with service delivery performance in the health sector with four components. (1) Promoting citizen monitoring of hospital performance; (2) Strengthening performance based incentive program in family medicine through social audits of primary healthcare institution; (3) Creating and enabling an environment for informed public dialogue in health; and (4) Knowledge and learning and project management.

This project is funded by a grant from Global Partnership For Social Accountability and will be implemented over a five-year period to include 70 hospitals and a representative sample of 120 primary healthcare facilities.
