At the impact level, this project aims to foster economic and firm growth, job creation, as well as an environment which promotes innovation (technology, R&D).



## Investment Description

- Inter-American Development Bank (IADB)

The Technical Cooperation will cost US\$3,483,000 total. Up to US\$1,198,750 will be financed by the IADB's Multilateral Investment Fund (MIF) Small Enterprise Development Facility; US\$2,284,250 will be funded through country counterpart financing.
