The specific objectives are i) support the institutional consolidation of the governance of disaster risk management in Uruguay at the national and local level, through technical assistance, studies and pilots to better understand the risks (threat, vulnerability , exposure); and to (ii) strengthen the procedures and tools for prevention, mitigation, and preparation through the improvement of the hydrometeorological Early Warning System (SAT).
