The proposed facility is for a senior, secured IFC A loan of up to US\$20 million (the “IFC Loan”) to JV LLC “Nyva Pereyaslavshchyny” (Nyva or the Company) through an allocation under the IFC COVID-19 response facility. Nyva is a leading Ukrainian pork producer. The IFC Loan will help Nyva address liquidity shortages that have emerged due to a sudden shortage of local bank financing in Ukraine. The proceeds of this facility do not change the operational footprint of the Company.
