### Project Description

In the transition to a competitive procurement scheme for renewable energy, the Serbian Ministry of Mining and Energy (the main beneficiary) has requested the assistance of the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development ("EBRD" or "the Bank") in further developing the necessary framework for, and for the implementation of, competitive RE auctions. The request of the Serbian authorities builds on the Bank's previous assistance over the past years in their strategy to support RE. This assistance has included technical cooperation aimed at the development of the Power Purchasing Agreement (PPA) in 2016, as well as policy dialogue focused on the enhancement of its bankability.
