## Project Description

According to bank documents, the project objective is to increase economic opportunities in IT services by improving firm capabilities and developing a supportive ecosystem. The project aims to shift the dynamic equilibrium of the Palestinian IT sector towards one of continuous upgrading of firm capabilities and employment growth. It will do so by strengthening the supply of firm capabilities, demand from buyers and investors, and by stimulating the absorption of knowledge in the ecosystem.

Project components include:

- i. Improving the capabilities of IT service companies
- ii. Increasing global demand and investments in the IT services sector
- iii. Strengthening coordination in the ecosystem
- iv. Project management and monitoring
