### Project Description

According to the Bank's website, the project will provide advisory support based on key areas of gender inequality in the law identified as regulatory constraints to women's economic participation. Preliminary diagnostic of Côte d'Ivoire's legal framework points to opportunities for reform. The project will focus on reforming laws in four aspects of women's economic lives. The project will explore conducting an analysis of government data collection systems to assess and recommend improvements to gender disaggregated data subject to buy-in by the government.
